STUDENT REQUIREMENTS

- Has participated in team building and community building through athletics, clubs, volunteer activities, etc.
- Is a person of honesty and integrity.
- Shows enthusiasm and school spirit in relation to school and classmates.
- Supports other students through friendship, kindness, inclusion and compassion.
- Is courageous in their ability to stand up for beliefs, others and issues.
- Must be a graduating senior attending a 4 year university.

NOMINATION PROCESS

The nominee process will be initiated from recommendations received from faculty or administration. (Self-nominations may also be considered with an accompanying letter of support from faculty or administration.)

Nominees must complete a scholarship application/500 word essay that outlines the candidate's qualities that match the Foundation's scholarship requirements. Must be included: student activities, GPA, examples of kindness, school spirit and inclusive behavior. A student resume must be attached.

An independent Selection Committee (non-foundation/ non-family members) will review and evaluate all nomination applications for determination of final recipients.
